Woodrow Wilson High School band director Bill Bailey tells the Register-Herald that the Flying Eagles will be joining 13 more high school bands from around the country to deliver the grand finale act of the halftime show. They will be performing "Dancing in the Streets" and "Uptown Funk" on January 2nd, at the Mercedes-Benz Superdome.

The Flying Eagles band has performed at the Gator Bowl in 2010 and the Chick-Fil-A Peach bowl in 2013.

While in New Orleans, the Flying Eagles will also get to tour a new national World War II museum and march down Decatur Street in the Sugar Bowl parade.
